NSYSL Intra-Club Player (ICP) Policy and Procedure:

All competitive teams playing in NSYSL will be allowed intra-club players for league games subject to the following:

- Intra-club players must currently be registered with USYSA within the same club as the team that they are playing with.
- Independent teams may play an intra-club player who is currently registered with USYSA and another independent team.
- Intra-club players can only play for one team on any given day.
- Intra-club players may not play for a team younger than they are eligible for.
- A team may use an intra-club player only if they have fourteen or fewer players available for that game, and listed on the roster; the only exception is if the intra-club player is used as a goal-keeper for at least one half of the game (please note as gk on roster).
- A maximum of four intra-club players can be used for any one game.
- The team receiving the ICP must write ICP next to the player's name on the roster and must present the player's pass to the referee prior to the game.
- The team that loans the ICP must not list the player on their roster on the same date.
- *All games played with Intra-club players are considered "official" and will be recorded as follows:
 - If one team uses Intra-club player(s) the game will be recorded as 1-0 loss for the team using ICP(s).
 - If both teams use Intra-club player(s) the game will be recorded as 0-0 tie.
