Club Pass (CP)

- 1). A Club Pass Player must currently be registered with Nevada Youth Soccer Association (State Association) and within the same club as the team that they are playing with.
- 2). Independent teams may play a Club Pass Player who is currently registered with Nevada Youth Soccer Association (State Association) and another independent team.
- 3). Club Pass Players may not play for a team younger than they are eligible for.
- 4). Club Pass Players may not be borrowed from a higher division team. EX: A Gold player may not be borrowed for a team playing in the Silver division.
- 5). A team may use a maximum of 3 Club Pass Players without forfeiting a game. More than 3 players will result in a forfeit.
- 6). A team may only use the amount of Club Pass Players up to the maximum roster.

Maximum rosters defined by Nevada State Youth Soccer Association are as follows:

U5 through U8 - 6 players

U9 through U10 - 12 players

U11 through U12 - 16 players

U13 through U14 - 18 players

U15 through U19 – 22 players – ONLY 18 may be on the roster per game.
